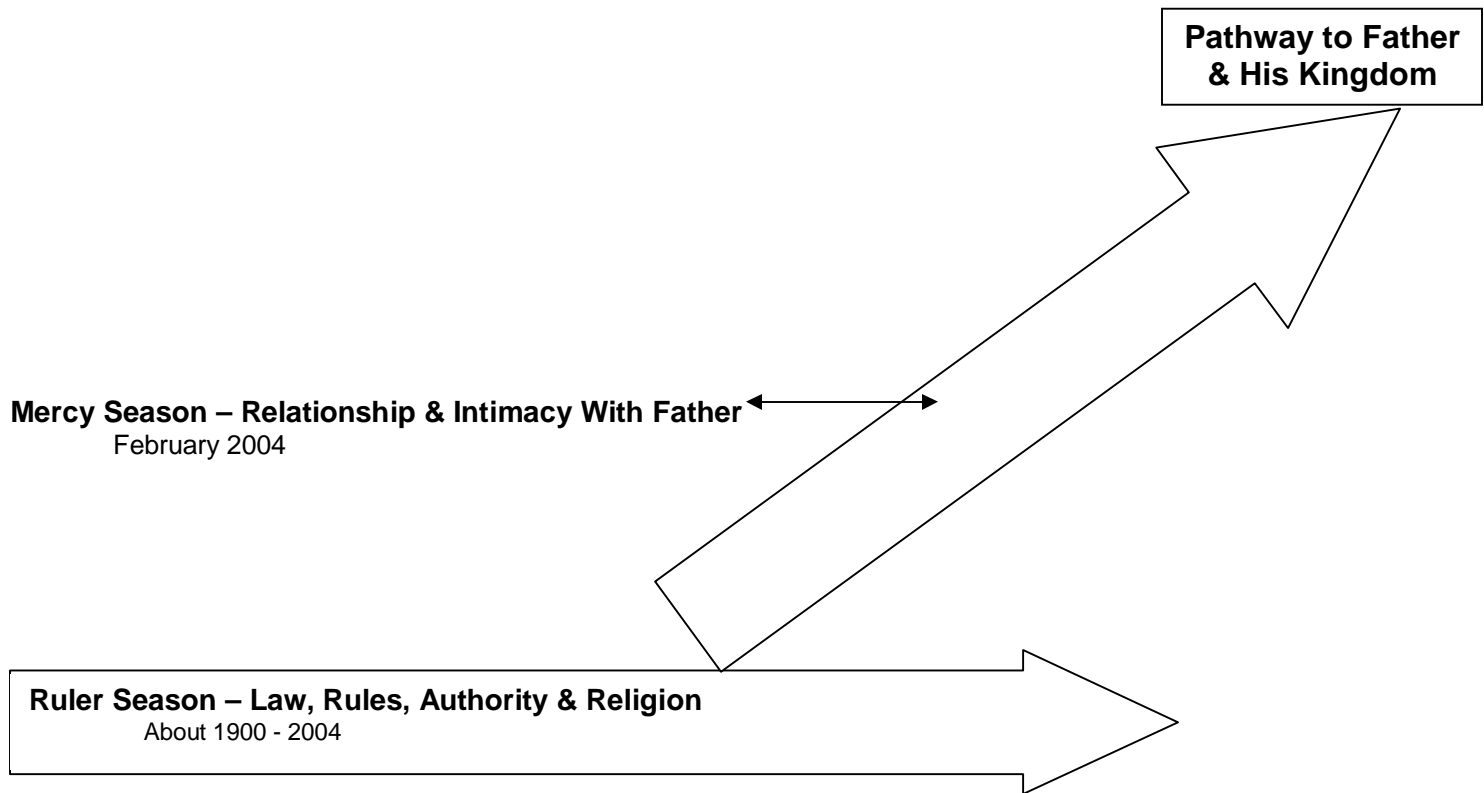


Places In The Father's Heart
